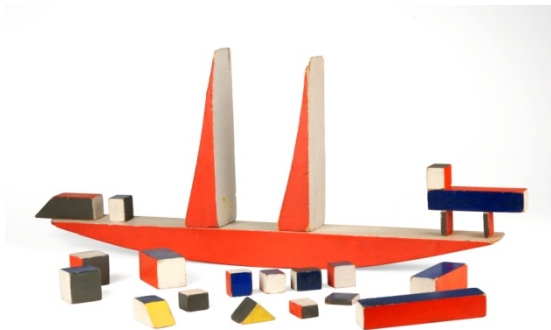

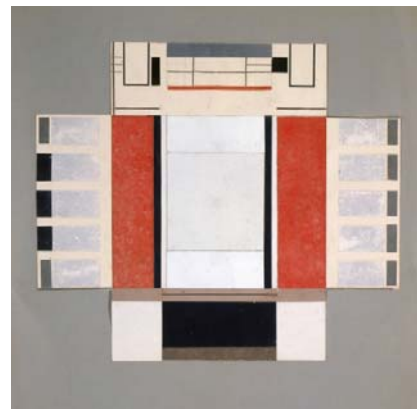

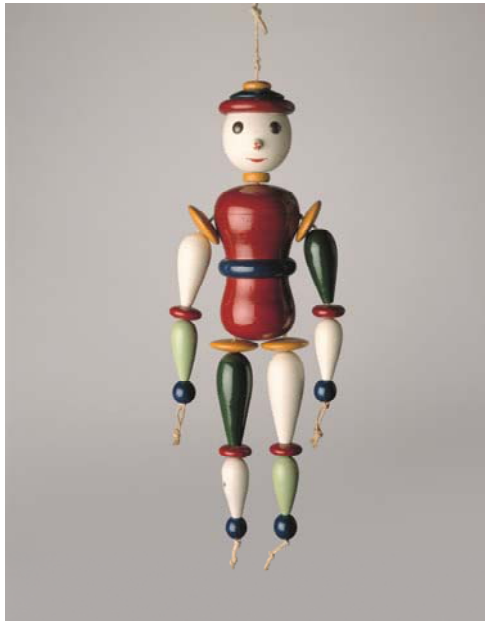
Marcel Breuer (design), Carpentry workshop of the Bauhaus Dessau (manufacturer), Children's Bed, 1927

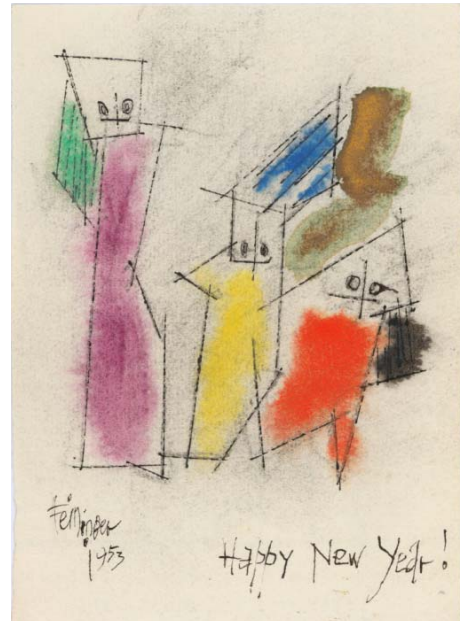
Alma Buscher (design), Large Ship Building Blocks, 1923

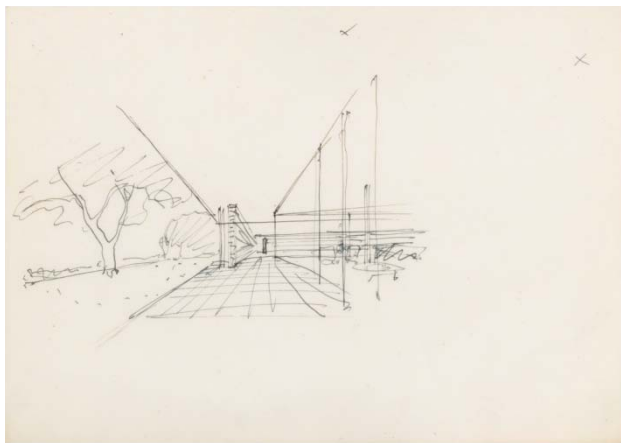
Heinrich Koch, Colour Plan of the Bauhaus Dessau, Canteen, 1926

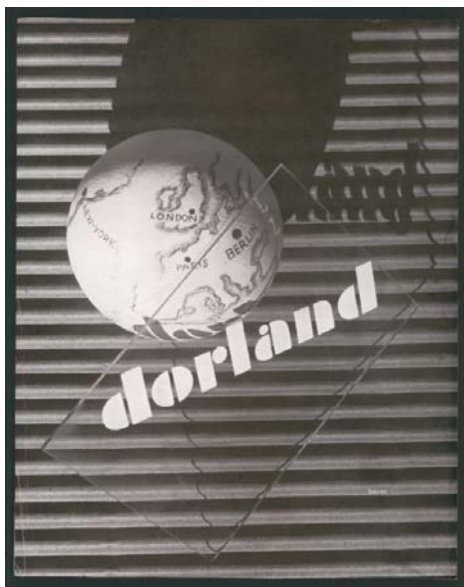
