Rush of visitors to see "original bauhaus"

More than 10,000 visitors during the first week

On Thursday last week "original bauhaus", the centenary exhibition of the Bauhaus-Archiv / Museum für Gestaltung, opened at the Berlinische Galerie. On the opening evening, 3,692 people visited the exhibition. In the first 8 days since the press conference a total of 10,073 visitors came.

Until 27 January 2020, "original bauhaus" is presenting more than 1,000 famous, familiar and forgotten Bauhaus originals and recounting the history behind the objects. "original bauhaus" features art and design from the holdings of the Bauhaus-Archiv, exceptional loans from international collections and artistic positions which take a new look at the Bauhaus legacy. On the basis of 14 key objects, the exhibition sheds light on how unique work and series, remake and original are inseparably linked in the history of the Bauhaus.
